Subject: BPCE in France joins Erasmus+ Master Loan Scheme

Dear Colleagues,

I am happy to inform you that on 1 December 2015 the European Investment Fund (EIF) and BPCE Group¹ will officially announce the signature of the first Erasmus+ Master Loan guarantee agreement with a French bank. This constitutes an important further step in the development of the Erasmus+ Master student loan facility.

Following the launch in June 2015 (through MicroBank in Spain), this second Erasmus+ guarantee agreement adds a further 30 million \in of loans, to become available to mobile Master students (both outgoing from and incoming into France), supported by an Erasmus+ guarantee of 5 million \in .

This 3-year contract provides for loans to some 2.000 students (up to a maximum of $12.000 \in$ for 1 year or $18.000 \in$ for a 2-year Master's). Master loans will be available within 6 months from the date of the agreement. BPCE is preparing a webpage² where students will be able to find information, allowing them to prepare their application in due time.

A signature event is taking place on 1 December 2015 at the BPCE headquarters in Paris, organised jointly by BPCE and the EIF.

BPCE Group (Banques Populaires – Caisses d'épargnes) from France operates through its subsidiary SOCAMA for this guarantee conract.
